



Zoo Etiquette

Welcome to the Calgary Zoo. We ask that you please be polite and courteous during your visit, follow these simple rules and, above all, provide a good example for all those who enjoy the zoo.

- 1. PLEASE TREAT ALL ANIMALS, PLANTS, AND STAFF WITH COURTESY** - Do not knock on glass, approach free flying birds or animals, feed the animals, pick flowers or throw coins in ponds. Loud and unruly behaviour unnecessarily stresses our animals and spoils the visit for other guests, and any abuse of staff is unacceptable.
- 2. THIS IS A NON-SMOKING FACILITY** – Smoking is only allowed in designated smoking areas. Refer to the visitor map for details.
- 3. PLEASE RESPECT SAFETY FENCES AND BARRIERS** – Please do not enter restricted areas in order to get closer to any of the animals or for any other reason.
- 4. APPROPRIATE ATTIRE** – Shirts and shoes are required and vulgar information on clothing is not permitted.
- 5. NOT ALLOWED AT THE ZOO** – Rollerblades, skates, roller heel shoes, skateboards, scooters, bicycles, balls, frisbees, whistles, balloons, and pets.
- 6. PERSONAL TRANSPORTATION DEVICES** – Personal motorized transportation devices are for our physically challenged visitors only.
- 7. DON'T GET LOST** – All children must be supervised by an adult at all times. Please designate a meeting place if your group becomes separated.
