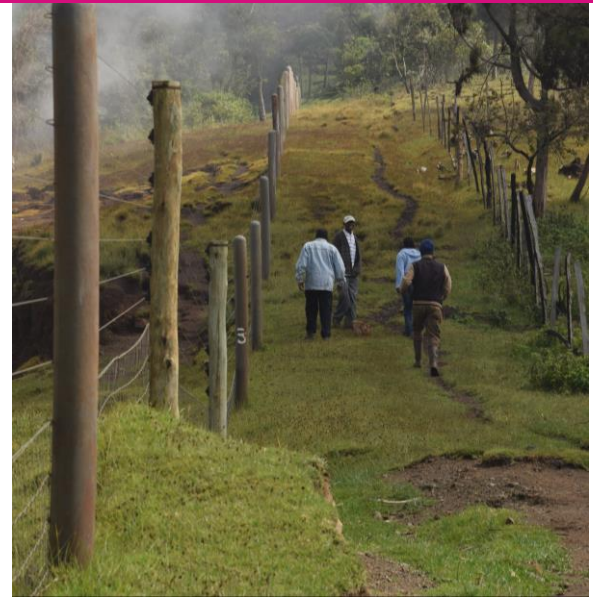
Creating Space for Wildlife

The Calgary Zoo community conservation teams are working with partners in Eburu Forest Reserve in Kenya to track endangered Mountain Bongo and learn how we can best protect them.

Part of that protection is the fence installed by Rhino Ark around the Eburu Forest Reserve. This fence helps save space for wildlife to keep their habitats separate from human activities.



We can all create habitat for wildlife, even in our own backyards!

1. Plant pollinator-friendly plants if you have a garden, to help butterflies and bumblebees
2. Clean up litter along pathways or in parks in your neighbourhood
