

Porcupines

Many animals, including porcupines, use their body colours as warning signs to help keep themselves safe from predators. Their patterns, colours, or spots tell other animals they want to be left alone, that they aren't tasty or may be poisonous to eat. This called **Aposematic Coloration**.
