What is a Recall Sound?

Keepers use recall sounds at the Calgary Zoo to call animals in for food or to shift to another habitat. In mixed-species habitats, each species will have its own sound.

Here are some of the sounds you will hear in the Savannah Building



The giraffes don't have a recall sound. They use a visual recall target stick, because they respond better to visual cues.

Humans associate sounds with meanings too! Often when we hear a certain sound, we know what action or source goes with it.
