1. Wood Bison.
2. Fire helps disperse seeds by opening cones.
3. Short muscular legs, compact body with low center of gravity and specialized hooves.
4. Flexible lips and tongues.
5. To help pregnant females compete for food with larger males.
6. Skoki is the grizzly bear that was brought to Calgary zoo because he was frequenting human areas. Relocated many times but kept returning. He was named bear 16 by researchers and renamed Skoki at the Calgary Zoo.
7. Form circle with horns facing out. Young inside circle. Muskox wait out predator in this position—as long as it takes.
8. Muscles for their forearms from digging and searching for food.
9. To aid in digestion. Moose, bighorn sheep, mountain goat, bison, caribou.
10. Puma, mountain lion, and catamount .
