## Primates – Answer Key

1. Black-and-white ruffed lemurs.
2. Silverback gorillas are the leaders of the troop. They are protectors of their family group. They also keep the peace within the group and lead the troop when moving to new locations.
3. Eastern black-and-white colobus monkeys.
4. Japanese macaques.
5. The Atlanta Zoo in Georgia, USA. He was in a bachelor herd of male gorillas.
6. King Julian is a misnomer because ring-tailed lemurs are led by females – not males. Therefore, it should be Queen Julia.
7. Prehensile is something that has adapted to grasping or wrapping around (like a hand). Some New World (South American) monkeys have prehensile tails to hang in the trees.
8. 100+ species of lemurs.
9. Red-fronted lemurs.
10. 7 species of primates - Western lowland gorillas, Eastern black-and-white colobus monkeys, Japanese macaques, mandrills, ring-tailed lemurs, red-fronted lemurs, black-and-white ruffed lemurs.
