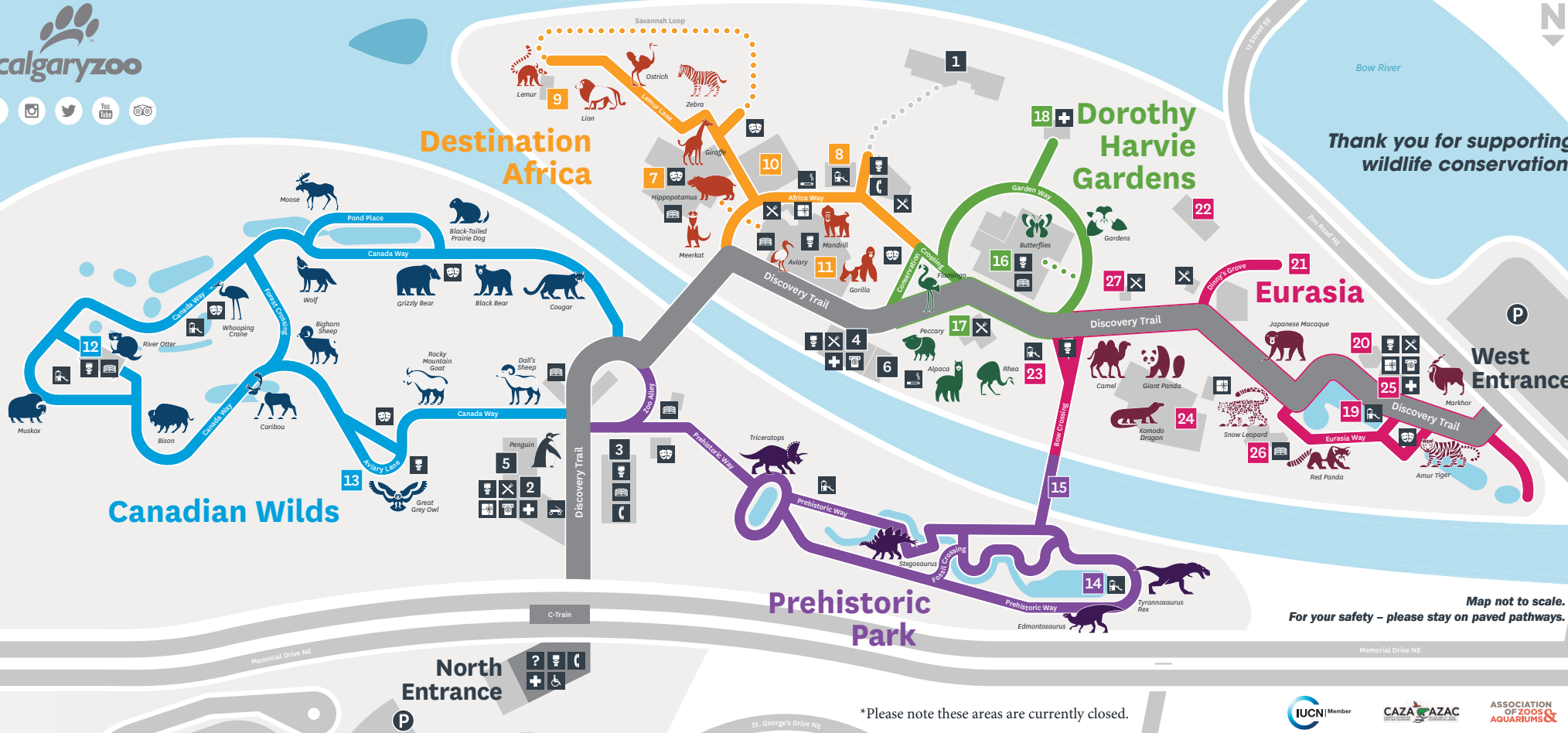

Canadian Wilds



Explore the winding pathways in our replica of the Rocky Mountain and northern forest ecosystems. Visit muskox, river otters, Dall's and bighorn sheep, elk, owls, prairie dogs, caribou, bison, whooping cranes and more.

Prehistoric Park



Travel back to a time when triceratops and iguanodonts roamed the earth. Discover fossils and slide through a massive tyrannosaurus rex skull! You will experience what Alberta might have looked like when dinosaurs reigned supreme.

Destination Africa
