Family Itinerary for a Half Day Visit (approx. 4 hours)

9:00 am – Welcome!

- Head directly into our Penguin Plunge habitat and visit with 5 different Penguinspecies – this immersive habitat is an absolute must see!

Visit time: approx. 20 minutes



9:25 – 11:00 am – Canadian Wilds

- From the exit path of Penguin Plunge take your next left and enter the Canadian Wilds!
- This beautiful park-like journey will take you across the Rocky Mountains and down through the rolling plains. You can encounter iconic Canadian species such as Bison, Wolves, Cougars, Grizzly Bears, and much more. Stop for a break by the critically endangered whooping cranes

Visit time: approx. 1 hour 25 minutes

11:00 – 11:45 am – Recharge with some Food & Beverage!

- Exit the Canadian Wilds and head south across the bridge and due west to Kitamba Café. Stop for a quickrefreshment such as a gourmet coffee or freshly made meal options

Visit time: approx. 45 minutes

11:45 – 1:00 pm – Gateway to Asia

- Now that you're refreshed, wander down Discovery Trail westward until you discover our Gateway to Asia. Be sure to spend some time at our Snow Leopard habitat and make your way back along the beautiful Amur Tigers
- If your visit finishes early, stop by our outdoor Gorilla habitat to see if the troop is playing outside on your way back to the exit! Destination Africa would be another must see if time permits
