



## Mission Zoopossible

No time to get out and smell the Zoo? Don't worry we can give your event a fun brain break. Each team will be tasked with running their own Zoo – from creating logos to animal breeding. Teams will take on Zoo and nature related challenges to complete the mission to make their Zoo the best. The teams with the highest points will be accredited!

### POSSIBLE CHALLENGES

1. Studbook Coordinator
  - Ever wondered how endangered species breeding programs work? You will be given all the background info on the Amur Tiger and then you get to be the matchmakers!
2. Zoology 101
  - You are presented with numerous, interesting biofacts (animal artefacts). As the Zoologists – you have to identify all the animals and parts.

**Duration:** typically 1.5 hours

#### **Prices:**

Offsite price: \$40.00 per person

“Within a catered event at the Zoo” price: \$25.00 per person

A catered event is an event with a full day room rental and a catered meal for a minimum of 30 people.

**Minimum # of participants:** 25 – smaller groups are welcome but the minimum cost will be based on 25 people

**Maximum # of participants:** 200

**Booking:** minimum of two weeks notice. To book with a banquet room and catering, please call 403-232-7770. To book offsite (at your location) please call 403-695-3806.

**Venue type:** ALL indoors – at your meeting location at tables

#### **Basic Itinerary:**

A staff member will meet you at your location and provide an introduction to the activities, go over ground rules and the timing of the program. This usually takes 10-15 minutes.

Your group will should already be split up into their teams of 4-8 people and be seated at tables – one table per team. Each team will be a running their own zoo. They will go thru 4 challenges that are located in a box on their table. Each challenge will be marked

as they complete them. There will be Zoo surprises along the way – teams with the best communication, creativity and time management will prosper.

At the end of the allotted time – all teams scores will be tallied up and the teams with the highest scores will become “accredited Zoos”. Finally, your race host conduct an informal debrief of the events, what they learned, what they found most challenging, etc.
